Cable Operated Hydraulic Systems

A cable operated system has an in-cab pedestal mounted control with two mechanical cables used to control the hydraulic unit.

- 1. Assemble jumper wire supplied with relay to small terminal shown in Fig. 2.
- 2. Place remaining end of jumper wire over the large relay terminal marked "BAT."
- 3. Connect wires to the same terminals on the new relay as they were connected to the relay being replaced. See Fig. 2.




WARRANTY
